Saint Mary's rules and regulations, as stated in the *Student/Parent Handbook*, will be enforced. (The *Handbook* is posted on the [Saint Mary's website](#).) Guests are asked to review the expectations before signing this form.

- Saint Mary's students are responsible for the behavior of their guests and need to share with their guest what appropriate behavior, language, dress and dancing looks like at Saint Mary's.
- ***All invited guests must be high school students and need to present a current high school student body card with a photo on it.***
- Saint Mary's students need to accompany their guests at check in before entering the dance.
- Guest names not appearing on the approved guest list at the door may not enter the dance.
- Regulations regarding possession/use of alcohol, vape pens, and any illicit items and materials will be strictly enforced.
 - *All persons attending the dance are subject to alcohol screening and search before entering.*
- *Students who have been dismissed from Saint Mary's are not allowed to return as guests.*

Chaperones at this dance will be Saint Mary's faculty and staff. If it is determined by a chaperone that a student's behavior or dancing is inappropriate, they will have to leave the dance floor and receive a referral to the Dean of Students. A guest's school may be notified.

Dress Code: The Homecoming Dance is a Semi-Formal Dance. Students not in compliance with the dress code will not be admitted to the dance.

Acceptable Semi-formal Attire:

- Dress shirt, dress pants, suit jacket, blazer, tie is optional.
- Appropriate length skirts, dresses, and jumpsuits may be worn. These garments must be mid-thigh length or longer. Dresses may be strapless or have spaghetti straps.
- Safe/appropriate footwear must be worn at all times. Black or white sneakers may be worn, but the following are preferred: heels, strappy sandals, dressy flats, dressy loafers, oxfords, lace-up shoes.

Unacceptable Semi-formal Attire:

- Undergarments must not be showing.
- No midriff can show (even when arms are raised). Two-piece dresses must overlap. Mesh/see-through inserts in the midriff are not allowed.
- The back or side of the dress must not be too low-cut or revealing. The back of the dress should not go below the natural waist. Corsets must be laced closed or adhere to the open back rule.
- Dress slits must not be higher than mid-thigh.
- No canes, ball caps, beanies, or sweatbands are permitted.
- No flip flops or bare feet.
- No jeans, jeggings, or sweatpants.
