come. In Jesus' Name. Amen.



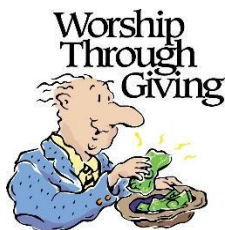

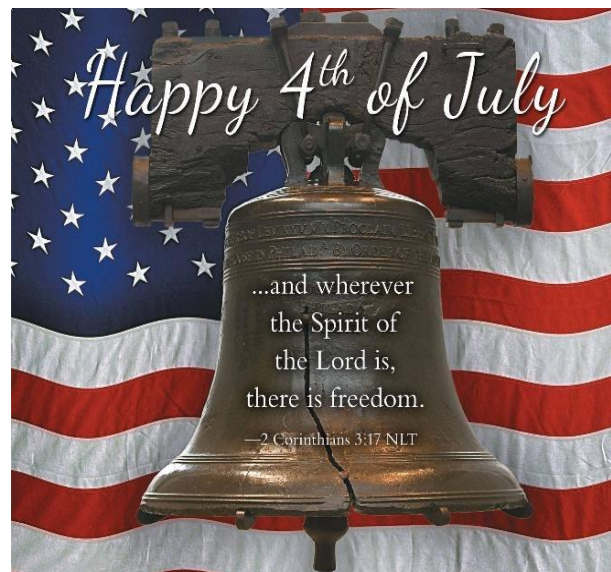
