MLB: Milwaukee Brewers vs. Cincinnati Reds - 1 Unit (+100) - 7:10pm ET

Brewers to win

Analysis:

The Brewers' recent form has surged unexpectedly as they embarked on a seven-game winning streak, culminating in a dominating sweep of the Phillies with a combined score of 28-11, signaling a potential turning point for their season. This momentum is bolstered by Aaron Civale, who, after being recalled, looked sharp in his latest outing against the Red Sox, allowing only one run over five innings during an extra-inning victory, suggesting he could be a key stabilizer for the Brewers' rotation. Meanwhile, the Reds are struggling despite Brady Singer's decent 6-3 record; his 4.60 ERA indicates he's not overpowering hitters, and the team's recent performance reflects instability, as they've gone 4-7 in their last 11 games after a mid-May five-game win streak, highlighting their offensive and pitching challenges and raising concerns about their ability to rebound soon. The Brewers are holding 53% of the ML bets but the Sharp money is heavy on Milwaukee with 85% of the money on the Brewers to win outright.

Analysis:

Paul Blackburn is finally set to make his 2025 debut for the Mets after enduring a challenging stretch marked by spinal and knee issues, and this return could be crucial for the team as they look to gain consistency in their pitching staff. The Mets also seem to have LA's number recently, having won seven of their last eight meetings and holding the Dodgers to just three runs over the past two games at Citi Field, indicating a strong offensive and defensive hold on the Dodgers' lineup. Los Angeles appears to be at a somewhat vulnerable point in their rotation, especially with their Monday starter Dustin May, whose 4.45 ERA suggests he's not been as sharp as in previous seasons, and the team as a whole may be facing additional challenges. The rivalry has added extra spice given the Mets still have a score to settle from the NLCS last October, making this matchup not just about current form but also about avenging past postseason heartbreak, and Blackburn's return could be pivotal in tipping the scales back in NY's favor. This play isn't for the soft or conservative bettors, the public is heavy on LA here with 74% of the ML bets and 61% of the money.
