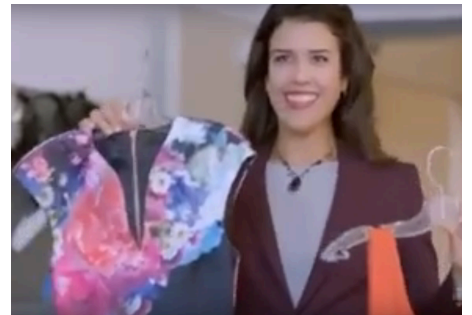

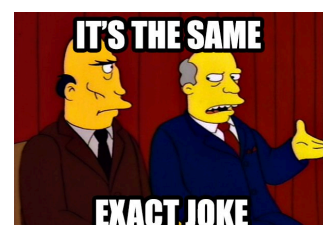
Netflix and chill : slang term, euphemism of sex

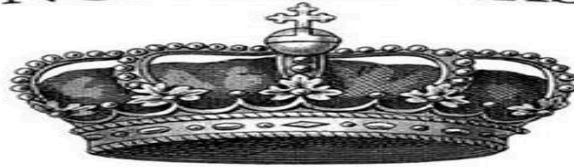
