I promise not to come to swim team events if I have a current illness or contagious infection		
I will be respectful and encouraging to my teammates. I will not use profanity or abusive language.		
I will bring only the essential items with me to swim team events. I understand that I am responsible for my own belongings. I will not hold the team liable for any belongings that are lost or stolen.		
I will be on time and be prepared with any necessary equipment needed during a swim team event.		
I will be respectful of both the team's equipment and that of my teammates, and use it properly.		
I will follow my coach's instructions and try my best during practices, meets and any other swim team event.		
I will do my best to have fun, improve my skills, and enjoy my time on the The Crossings Swim Team.		
I will not spit in the pool, on deck, or near the facility at any time.

POOL RULES AMENDMENT

- Children under the age of 14 must be accompanied by a responsible party who can pass a swim test.
- Members must be in possession of a pool fob/pass to access the pool and pavilion area. Members must activate the entry gate using their fob/pass and sign into the register. There is no sharing of pool fobs.
- All members and their guests are required to follow all posted and published pool rules. Any violation by a member or member's guest could subject the member to suspension of pool privileges and fines.
- If you are sick do not use the pool. If you become sick while at the pool, provide information for our incident report. Leave the pool area immediately.
- Individuals with open sores, colds, infections, bandages, or communicable disease are prohibited from using the pool.
- Access to the pool and pavilion area is permitted from 6am until Attendant closing, or by special permission by The Crossings HOA Board of Directors or designee.
- 4 Guests per household are allowed and are the responsibility of the residents of the Crossings (This is to prevent overcrowding).
- Wading pool (Kiddie pool) is restricted to members accompanying infants, toddlers, or handicapped individuals. All other members are expressly prohibited. NOTE: Attendants are NOT responsible for monitoring the Wading Pool. Responsible parties must be attentive at all times.
- No glass or any breakable items are allowed in the pool, on the pool deck, or in the pavilion area.
- Family friendly and pool appropriate swim attire must be worn to use the pool. (No street clothes that could damage the pool).
- Diving, running, and rough play (i.e. pushing, dunking, aggressive physical contact, or other inappropriate behavior) is strictly prohibited. NOTE: Diving is allowed during swim team practice and meets, under the supervision of the swim team coaching staff only.
- Abusive, aggressive, or foul language will not be tolerated.
- Food and drinks, except for water in clear plastic containers, are not allowed in the pool.
- Pets are not allowed into the pool and pavilion area, nor are they allowed to be leashed or tied to any portion of the pool, Pavilion, Playground, or other common area while the member uses the pool or pavilion.
- Smoking and vaping (e-cigarettes of any kind) permitted only outside of the fenced pool area.
- The use of over-sized floats is prohibited.
- The lap lane is for lap swimming only.

POOL EQUIPMENT

- Pool furniture may not be reserved for use at a later time. You may leave your personal items on furniture you are currently using, while in the pool area. Please take all your belongings when you leave the pool area.
- The pool company, Aquatech Pool Management Group, will be out daily to clean the pool, check chemicals, and clean and restock the restrooms. If you notice anything while at the pool that might need immediate attention or repair, please call the APMG contact number posted on the announcement board at the pool house.
- If there is a restroom item that needs to be restocked and cannot wait until the following day, please call APMG or scan the QR Code that is hung in each bathroom.
- Pool maintenance equipment is not to be tampered with at any time.

HYGIEN AND RESPECTFULNESS

- Please consider showering before entering the pool. For this purpose, the shower area should remain unblocked by pool furniture.
- No smoking (this includes but is not limited to cigarettes, pipes, cigars, e-cigs) or vaping is permitted within the pool facility. Smoking is in the pool parking lot. Cigarette butts must be placed in a trash receptacle after being fully extinguished.
- No one who is bleeding or has open, uncovered wounds may swim in the pool.
- Children in need of a diaper change must be changed in a restroom at the pool.
- All trash shall be deposited by Homeowners and their guests in the provided receptables. Please clean up before leaving the pool facility to help keep The Crossings Community beautiful.
- Babies, small children in diapers, or children who are not toilet trained are only permitted in the pool with swim diapers or rubber pants over the diaper. Exposed disposable diapers are not permitted in the pool.
- In the event anyone has defecated or vomited in the pool, please report the occurrence immediately. Per CDC rules, the pool must be shut down, drained, and cleaned. Everyone must exit the pool facility immediately. Please report to Cusick at (704) 544-7779 in this event.
- No pets are permitted within the gated pool area at any time unless authorized by the Board.
- No profanity or foul language is permitted in the pool area.
- Excessive noise will not be permitted to interfere with the enjoyment of other pool users.
- Music from phones or portable speakers must be kept at a low volume so as not to disturb other guests in the pool area.
- The phone at the pool is for emergency purposes only, not for personal use.
- A lost and found bin is maintained at the pool house. You may leave found items or request to retrieve items from this bin. If you find something of value or importance and don't want to leave it, please contact Cusick.

CONTACT AND REPORTING CONCERNS

- For any concerns or complaints, please contact Cusick management at (704) 544-7779. Regular office hours are 8:30am – 4:30pm M-Th and 8:30am – 2pm on Fridays.
- The Cusick answering service/emergency line for after hours and weekend calls should only be used for true emergencies such as water leaks, power outages at the pool house, glass in the pool, or if someone defecates or vomits in the pool.
