Scholarship Application Procedures

Welcome to the CHS Scholarship webpage. You have accomplished the first step toward receiving some kind of scholarship by visiting this webpage! The next thing you need to do is scroll through the list of scholarships, realize the opportunities available, and begin filling out applications! Students are required to return all college and scholarship applications and transcript requests **at least 7 days** in advance of published deadlines. If you are early in your high school career, we encourage you to read through the listings to see what the offerings are; you still have time to focus your energy toward a specific area to qualify to receive a particular scholarship. Opportunities are out there – it takes initiative and time, but could be very worthwhile. Good luck!

- 1. Most scholarships can be applied for online, but for scholarships that do not list a website, see the school counselor for the paper application.
- 2. Please apply early! If there are documents that your counselor needs to submit with your application (transcripts, letters of recommendation, etc.), remember to let us know *at least 7 days* in advance so that we can prepare the documents prior to the scholarship deadline.
- 3. A typed, computer processed, or very neatly written in black ink application is essential in the filling process. Poorly completed applications are unacceptable.
- 4. For any application needing a recommendation letter, allow the teacher being asked *at least two weeks* to prepare the letter. Ask them to write a general endorsement letter so it can be used for scholarships or college applications. It is a good practice to write the teacher a thank you note.
- 5. Preparing a resume is advantageous for the applications that ask for a list of community service activities, extracurricular activities, work experience, and accomplishments.
- 6. Envelopes addressed to the organization with the required postage are appreciated.
- 7. If you are awarded a scholarship, send the organization chairman a thank you note explaining how much you appreciate the financial assistance.

8. If the scholarship is highlighted in goldenrod, it may not be available at this time or we have not yet received an updated version.
