1. Scope

- 1.1. This policy applies to the Prep and Senior schools.
- 1.2. Exceptions for genuine (e.g. religious reasons) will be permitted after approval from the Head of College.

2. School Shop

- 2.1. <u>School Colours</u> supplies Queen's College uniform. School Colours is a leading supplier of school uniform and sports kit.
- 2.2. Their website can be accessed at https://www.schoolcoloursdirect.co.uk/. Use the 'school finder' tab to go to Queen's College.
- 2.3. Its service includes:
 - 2.3.1. Internet-based ordering (available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week);
 - 2.3.2. A personalised fitting service, by appointment, at our in-school measuring event;
 - 2.3.3. Postage-free standard UK delivery service direct to your home or office;
 - 2.3.4. Postage-free returns label to return items for whatever reason.

3. Labelling of clothing

3.1. All clothing and equipment should be named on the inside of the garment.

4. Hairstyles, make-up, and nails

- 4.1. Hair must be of a natural colour and hair that extends beyond shoulder level should be fully tied back, excepting Year 11 and Sixth Form; hair slides, bands and ribbons must be plain and in school colours. Hair extensions are not permitted.
- 4.2. Make-up, nail extensions, gel nails or nail varnish are not allowed, except at Sixth Form Level where pupils' make-up must be unobtrusive and also not interfere with work in practical subjects.

5. Jewellery

- 5.1. Bracelets, rings and other jewellery are not allowed. The only exceptions being:
 - 5.1.1. Earrings, small studs, or small and fine hoops, with only one in each ear, are permitted (the studs may only be small gold, silver or pearl round balls);
 - 5.1.2. One fine gauge chain/necklace may be worn; or
 - 5.1.3. At Sixth Form level, pupils may wear jewellery which is unobtrusive the Head of Sixth Form will give guidance.
- 5.2. Jewellery should be removed for PE/games; new earrings must be taped until they can be removed.

6. School uniform and appearance

- 6.1. All items of uniform must conform to the regulation uniform lists: Prep, Upper Prep; and Senior. Reference to these lists should avoid the purchase of inappropriate items and so avoid unnecessary extra expense.
- 6.2. The dress and appearance of pupils must at all times reflect well on the individual and the school.
- 6.3. Full uniform or games kit must be worn until 5.30pm on weekdays; a mixture of informal clothes and uniform is never permitted.
- 6.4. Pupils are required to have a high standard of personal hygiene and be clean shaven.
- 6.5. School uniform should be worn neatly while attending school and in travelling to and from school unless an explicit exception has been made by a member of staff.
- 6.6. Damaged or soiled uniform should not be worn; such items should be cleaned, repaired, or replaced at the earliest opportunity
- 6.7. For Senior School pupils:
 - 6.7.1. Blazers must be worn when travelling to and from School and throughout the school day unless permission has been given to remove it, for example in a classroom. Blazers may be removed in day bases but replaced when leaving.
 - 6.7.2. Hoodies must not be worn with the school uniform.
 - 6.7.3. Jumpers may only be worn with a blazer over.
- 6.8. Shirts should always be 'tucked in' and worn with top buttons fastened.
- 6.9. Uniform must always be worn in detention.
- 6.10. Boarders may wear informal clothes in supper (but not hats or hoods) and on Saturday and Sunday, except for formal school engagements, fixtures, team teas etc.
- 6.11. The wearing of games kit in lessons and in the Dining Room is not permitted, save on specific occasions when clean kit may be worn with tracksuit bottoms or QC black performance leggings.
- 6.12. Hats, caps and other items of casual clothing may not be worn with uniform at any time, except in sunny weather when a black or white cap can be worn at break, lunch and during sport, or in winter when a school issue woolly hat may be worn.
- 6.13. Outer garments raincoats, anoraks etc
 - 6.13.1. Prep must be plain black or a school-branded coat with a hood.
 - 6.13.2. Senior must be dark in colour and not leather or fur, with discreet logos only if any.

7. Sixth form uniform

- 7.1. At the Sixth Form level, the dress code required is executive style:
 - 7.1.1. Formal 'muted' suit with skirt, trousers or shift dress; or

- 7.1.2. An awarded colours blazer with skirt, trousers or shift dress:
- 7.1.3. skirts and trousers must be formal and neat, excessively flared or skin-tight trousers or skirts are not acceptable; and
- 7.1.4. skirt length must be no shorter than just above the knee
- 7.1.5. A formal classic shirt which may be:
 - 7.1.5.1. white, plain pastel-coloured or striped, with a Sixth Form or other authorised tie (sensibly tied); or
- 7.1.6. A plain business-like blouse/collarless top or plain-knit top.
 - 7.1.6.1. No crop tops, low necklines or strappy vest-tops
- 7.2. Blazer or smart formal jackets must be worn during the school day and when conducting school tours or on other formal occasions
- 7.3. Jackets may be removed in the Sixth Form Centre
- 7.4. A single colour, plain knit v-necked or quarter-zip (non-sports) jumper in a dark colour may be worn under a blazer/jacket
- 7.5. Shoes should be smart and must be black or brown, leather or leather effect

8. Senior School Summer Dress

- 8.1.1. In hot weather (forecast to be very warm for a sustained period), after announcement by the Head of Senior School, uniforms may be adjusted for 'summer dress'.
- 8.1.2. Summer dress is likely to include:
 - 8.1.2.1. removal of blazers/suit jackets during the school day only if jumpers are not worn;
 - 8.1.2.2. option of revere collar blouses, short-sleeved shirts, or shirt sleeves rolled; and
 - 8.1.2.3. removal of ties (if blazer is also removed or when wearing revere collar).
- 8.1.3. With the skirt uniform, white ankle socks may be worn instead of black tights.
- 8.1.4. Summer dress should remain 'smart', notably with shirts tucked in.
- 8.1.5. Blazers/jackets and ties should always be worn to and from school and should be at school every day so that we can revert, as required.
- 8.1.6. If the weather demands summer dress, there should be no additional items worn without blazers/jackets and ties, specifically:
 - 8.1.6.1. no jumpers/sweaters/cardigans;
 - 8.1.6.2. no coats; and
 - 8.1.6.3. no t-shirts or vests under shirts.
