Assessment Types and Grading Scale:

Teacher-made quizzes and tests, oral questioning, observation, projects, and creative writing graded with rubrics will be used. District Math tests will be given at the end of each math unit. Reading records will be administered at least three times a year. Spelling tests will be given weekly. Phonics Skills tests will be given as needed.

Missed Work:

Provision for make-up of school work missed during excused absences shall be coordinated with the teacher(s) concerned at the earliest time possible, but should not exceed five (5) school days after the student returns to school.
