Learning Goal:

Students will discuss a policy with a peer.

Learning Objectives:

- (K) Students will know facts about one policy Ruth Bader Ginsburg dissented.

Outcome:

Students will write a paragraph arguing for or against a policy mentioned in the book that Ruth Bader Ginsburg has dissented. Students will then use this paragraph to practice discussion skills with a partner. At the end of the discussion, students will shake hands and play a board game.
