SLASH PILE The slash pile has been pushed up and is ready for use. You may pull up and unload from any side of the pile. Thank you for backing up as close as possible.

The previous year's ashes, partially burned material, and scattered debris on the north end of the slash pile have been moved, creating a larger area for dumping slash.

Thank you for all of the hard work you are doing on your properties and throughout our community to help reduce wildfire risk. Your efforts make a noticeable difference and help keep Wold safer for everyone.

Materials Allowed in the Slash Pile

- Natural forest debris, including branches, logs, stumps, pine needles, brush and other vegetation
- *All materials must be in their natural state.*

Materials NOT Allowed in the Slash Pile

- Painted, stained, treated, or manufactured wood products
- Boards, posts, decking materials, wood pellets, or lumber
- Wood containing nails, bolts, screws, wire, or attached items (such as birdhouses)
- Garbage or household trash
- Carpet, paneling, or construction materials
- Any non-natural debris

CHIMNEY SWEEP OPPORTUNITY – June 2026

If you are interested in having your chimney cleaned, *Doug with First Choice Chimney of Laramie* will be coming to the Wold community in June (exact date to be determined) and has availability to service additional cabins.

- Complete chimney sweep and cleaning
- Cleaning performed from the inside whenever possible
- Exterior work when needed (Doug has a lift available)
- \$200 per chimney cleaning and inspection (10% discount for cash payments)
- Travel charge of \$2 per mile (one way) if only a single chimney is scheduled. Savings if two or more chimneys are scheduled for the same trip
