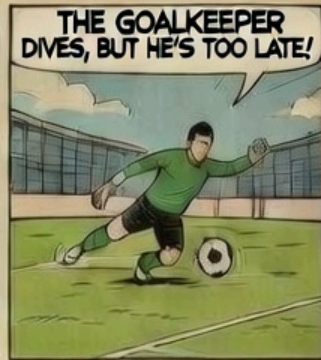
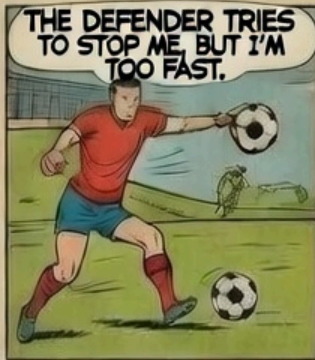

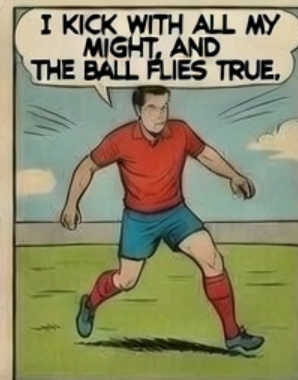

Quick Review + New Rules

- **HAS** → he, she, it (singular third person) Example: She **has** a smartphone. / The phone **has** many apps.
- **HAVE** → I, you, we, they (all others) Example: They **have** cool bikes. / I **have** homework.

New! Questions & Negatives

- Yes/No questions: Do + I/you/we/they + have...? Does + he/she/it + have...?
- Negatives: don't have / doesn't have

Examples:

- Do you **have** a pet? → Yes, I **do**. / No, I **don't**.
- Does he **have** a car? → Yes, he **does**. / No, he **doesn't**.
- We **don't have** class today.
- It **doesn't have** Wi-Fi.
