- c. Nelson Patsy sent a newsletter to launch attendees; approach librarian about climate book list
- **d. Dover Kristine/Cynthia attended** March 3 NH Dem Party platform listening sessions recommended environment, work force, education; Dover Dems initiating a reusables campaign partnering with library on Earth Day events; working with the City's resilience coordinator; willing to share materials; pamphlets available on reuse, replace options on TTT website
- e.
