Teacher Technology Package Setup Guide for Mac

Below you will find a list of items that are included in the technology package, followed by some steps on how to get everything up and running.

Included in your package are...

One 21" Monitor
One set of Logitech speakers
One Wired USB Keyboard
One Wired USB Mouse
One AVerMedia Webcam
One 4-port USB Hub (Clearwater)
One 6 ft HDMI cable

The items listed above are designed to work with your district laptop.

(NOTE: Macbooks from Good Hope, please continue to use your USB-C hub that was provided along with your Macbook. There is not a standard USB port on your Mac, so any connection would need to go through that hub. If your current USB-C hub is not functioning properly, please reach out to your site admin.)

The 4-port USB hub (or USB-c hub) should be used as needed to plug in the keyboard, mouse, and/or webcam and can plug into ANY open USB port on your laptop. As in the picture below, all three of the devices can be connected to the hub, and the hub plugged into one USB port on the laptop.



If you have more than one USB port on your laptop, it is recommended to use one port for the webcam, and then the other port for the USB hub.

The webcam is Plug and Play meaning it does not need software or drivers to be installed. Your laptop should automatically detect the webcam and it should be available to use after it's connected.

The webcam has a center piece that slides open and closed to cover the camera as needed.



The 6 ft HDMI is to be used for your 2nd monitor connection. One end would plug in to the monitor as shown below and the other end to the HDMI port on your laptop *(or for GH, your USB-c hub)*



Once both ends are connected and the monitor is powered on, it will automatically detect and start displaying the image on the screen.
