Glossary

Adventure Lab - community-generated scavenger hunts that let you uncover hidden gems, learn local trivia, discover landmarks, and everyday treasures

CCC - Civilian Conservation Corps - a group hired by President Franklin D. Roosevelt for jobs during hard times in the 1930s

Corral - a pen for livestock

Cypress Trees - one group of evergreen trees having tiny scale-like leaves

Endangered animals - an animal that is in danger of becoming extinct

Equestrian - relating to horses or horseback riding

Franklin D. Roosevelt - 32nd President who served for 12 years from 1933 to 1945

Foliage - the leaves on a plant or tree

The Great Depression - a severe economic downturn in the United States from 1929 through World War II

Merit Badges - an award given to recognize a skill or achievement, especially in Scouts

Murphy Bed - a bed that folds up and stores against a wall

New Deal - a group of US government programs of the 1930s

Red-cockaded Woodpecker - a small, rare, and endangered woodpecker with a red streak on its head

Shuttlecock - a small light, cone-shaped object used in the sport of badminton

Travel bug - a trackable tag that can be attached to an item to track its progress as it moves from cache to cache or person to person

Trail riding - riding horses outdoors on trails, natural terrain, and forest roads

Ultimate Outsider - when a person has been to all of the South Carolina state parks
