Arriving

- Students will enter the program at about 3:30 (3:25)
- Park on the street
- Enter through the glass doors in the second parking lot
- Students will put all of their belongings on the tables labeled for their age group.
- Students should sit at their assigned tables (for some age groups at their assigned seats which will be designated by their nametags)

Dinner

- After the students are sitting they will be dismissed one by one to grab their dinner
- Students should take one of each of the items offered for the meal, and should take the whole meal not just part of it.
- After finished eating students should raise their hands to be allowed to throw their trash away
- A few students will be wiping down the tables as they finish eating. Help the students on the tables to be mindful and respectful of this

Hallways

- Students will need a pass to go into the hallways (this includes bathroom and the water fountain)
- Voice level zero is expected at all times in the hallways
- Students can only use the bathrooms that are in the hallways with the classrooms being used
 - Not including the bathrooms that are past the library
- Students should never go upstairs or to their lockers during club time
- Students will be called, through a walkie talkie that the staff have, about being picked up

During homework time students should be either doing homework or reading
