<u>Powtoon</u>: to make simple animations

Wideo: simple web-based animations and videos

Stupeflix: video creator (make free 20 minute long videos)

Masher: video mashup creator

<u>AuthorSTREAM</u>: turn PPTs into Flash videos that you may embed on a website)

Royalty Free Video links (free stock video footage)

<u>Public Domain Flicks</u>: movies (some famous ones) that are now in the public domain so they are fair to use
