<p>This month we will begin and complete Eureka Module 2. We will be working with and learning the properties of flat and solid shapes. At home, you can encourage your child to identify the characteristics of different shapes they see around the house. For example, does this shape have straight sides or curved sides? What is the name of this shape? How many sides does this shape have?</p>	<p>This month we will be working on Benchmark Unit 2. In this unit, students read and compare different stories to identify characters, settings, and major events of a story. We will be practicing retelling stories using key details.</p>

<p>This marking period we will continue studying weather conditions and patterns over time. We will be asking questions to obtain information about the weather in order to prepare for, and respond to, severe weather.</p>	<p>This marking period we will be studying maps and globes, and how they can be used to describe location.
