Course Overview
<p>The Reading Mastery Program features extensive practice in decoding, vocabulary building, comprehension strategies and writing. The program includes several components and activities, including a range of extensive literature, daily practice in language arts, and open-ended comprehension questions. It uses the Direct Instruction method to help students master essential decoding and comprehension skills. Student's progress is closely monitored and assessed at designated benchmarks.</p> <p>The expectation is that each student participates in the daily reading practice, the oral comprehension component and completes the workbook questions. Oral reading fluency will be measured by checkouts every 10 lessons; mastery tests of comprehension will also occur every 10 lessons.</p> <p>Students will be exploring a range of fiction and non fiction writing genres. Throughout the course students will be able to write simple sentences, use punctuation appropriately, and leave spaces between words in a sentence.</p>
