An open letter to Canadian newsrooms on covering Israel-Palestine

"The Middle East is complicated."

"We need to hear both sides."

"Everyone has a lot of emotions about this."

These are just some of the excuses news editors have provided to Canadian journalists trying to cover the escalating violence against Palestinians.

The lack of nuanced Canadian media coverage of forced expulsions and indiscriminate airstrikes over the last three days, which have so far [killed](#) at least 137 Palestinians, including 36 children, has been disappointing. (This was the number of casualties at the time of writing this letter)

As journalists, we cannot selectively choose which international human rights violations to report on.

This past year, Canadian media has reckoned with and acknowledged the lack of diversity and nuance in covering issues of human rights. The work has just started.

Our industry rallied to properly cover the Black Lives Matter protests after the brutal police killing of George Floyd, and the disproportionate impacts of the pandemic on marginalized communities at home and around the world. We are learning to report on Indigenous experiences and issues in a nuanced way that recognizes the long historical impact of colonialism. Why shouldn't Palestinians be afforded the same nuance?

According to the United Nations and countless human rights organizations around the world (including ones based within Israel), what's happening in the Occupied Palestinian Territories is a "[grave breach of international law](#)." Some groups believe the attacks amount to an "ethnic cleansing."¹² It should be covered as such.

Dispossession is not complicated.

Violence against innocent civilians and children is not complicated.

Police aggression and state sanctioned racism is not complicated.

Journalists cover these issues all the time.

So why do we tip toe around coverage of Israel and Palestinians?

It's time for Canadian newsrooms to carry out the necessary due diligence and report on this region with nuance and context. For that to happen, Canadian newsrooms will have to first acknowledge their failings.

Anyone who has worked in a Canadian newsroom has encountered the reluctance or resistance to covering Israel and the Occupied Palestinian Territories. Canadian style guides still ban the use of the word "Palestine" in coverage; this has led to many [corrections](#) over the years. Racialized journalists have reported feeling overly scrutinized, or even censored, after every story pitch on this region. The unfair standard applied to these story pitches has only added to the [burden](#) they feel in diversifying Canadian media coverage.

Unfortunately, newsroom leaders are skittish, fearing the deluge of complaints that often follows coverage. The deep reluctance to cover the ongoing nature of the Israeli occupation leads to urgent breaking news coverage that never includes the context that surrounds the issue. This content almost always centres around Israeli politicians and organizations, and representatives of the Israeli government and military; rarely are Palestinian voices ever centred or featured.

A recent Al Jazeera [column](#) highlighted only two Canadian publications reported on a new Human Rights Watch [report](#) that found Israel was guilty of decades-long crimes against humanity against Palestinians: Canadian Press and The Globe and Mail. Mainstream Israeli groups tracking human rights abuses against Palestinians like [B'Tselem](#) have done the same.

The CBC, Canada's public broadcaster, did not have any coverage on the HRW report. Derek Stoffel, the CBC's world news editor and former Middle East correspondent, explained the silence by saying that his newsroom did "not have the reporter resources on this day to devote to it."

We've all heard this before. But the deaths of innocent people anywhere in the world, let alone a highly contentious region where many Canadians have vested interest, merits in-depth, fair and balanced coverage.

Our ask is simple: That all the tenets of journalism should apply to Canadian coverage of Occupied Palestinian Territories moving forward. Fair and balanced coverage should include historical and social context, reporters with knowledge of the region and, crucially, Palestinian voices.

Une lettre ouverte aux salles de nouvelles canadiennes au sujet de la couverture médiatique de la situation en Israël-Palestine

"Le Moyen-Orient est compliqué."

"Nous devons écouter les deux camps."

"Tout le monde ressent beaucoup d'émotions à ce sujet."

Voilà seulement quelques-unes des excuses que les éditeurs de nouvelles ont données aux journalistes canadiens qui tentent de couvrir la montée des violences contre les Palestiniens.

Le manque de nuance de la couverture médiatique canadienne des expulsions forcées et des frappes aériennes aveugles des trois derniers jours, qui [ont tué](#) au moins 137 Palestiniens, incluant 36 enfants, est décevante. (Il s'agit du nombre de victimes recensées lors de la rédaction de cette lettre)

En tant que journalistes, nous ne pouvons pas choisir sélectivement quelles violations des droits humains internationaux nous couvrons.

Au cours de la dernière année, les médias canadiens ont pris en compte et reconnu le manque de diversité et de nuance dans la couverture des questions relatives aux droits humains. Le travail ne fait que commencer.

À la suite du meurtre de George Floyd par un policier, notre secteur s'est mobilisé afin de couvrir correctement les manifestations de Black Lives Matter ainsi que les impacts disproportionnés que la pandémie a eu sur les communautés marginalisées au pays et partout dans le monde. Nous sommes entrain d'apprendre à reconnaître les impacts de longue durée du colonialisme. Pourquoi est-ce que les Palestiniens n'ont pas droit aux mêmes nuances?

Selon les Nations Unies et d'innombrables organisations pour la défense des droits humains à travers le monde (incluant celles basées en Israël), ce qui se passe dans les Territoire Palestiniens Occupés est une "[grave infraction au droit international](#)". Certains groupes croient que les attaques correspondent à un "nettoyage ethnique". Elles devraient être couvertes en tant que telles.

La dépossession n'est pas compliquée.

La violence contre des civil.es et enfants innocent.es n'est pas compliquée.

Les agressions policières et le racisme sanctionné par l'État ne sont pas compliqués.

Les journalistes couvrent ces problèmes constamment.

Alors pourquoi faut-il tourner autour du pot lorsqu'il est question d'Israël et des Palestiniens?

Il est temps pour les salles de nouvelles canadiennes de dûment faire preuve de diligence et de faire des reportages nuancés et contextualisés sur la région. Pour que cela soit possible, les salles de nouvelles canadiennes devront d'abord reconnaître leurs échecs.

Quiconque a travaillé dans une salle de nouvelles canadienne a dû faire face à la réticence et à la résistance qui accompagnent toute couverture d'Israël et des Territoires Palestiniens Occupés. Les guides de style canadiens interdisent encore l'utilisation du mot "Palestine" lors de la couverture; cela a mené à plusieurs [corrections](#) au cours des ans. Les journalistes racisés ont rapporté se sentir surveillés, censurés même, après avoir proposé des histoires portant sur la région. Les standards injustes qui sont imposés à ces propositions d'histoires ont seulement augmenté le fardeau qu'elles/ils ressentent lorsqu'elles/ils contribuent à diversifier la couverture médiatique canadienne.

Malheureusement, les chefs de bureau de nouvelles sont frileux. Ils ont peur des avalanches de plaintes qui font souvent suite à ce type de couverture. La réticence profonde à la couverture de la nature de l'occupation israélienne en cours mène à une couverture par voie de nouvelles urgentes de dernière heure qui n'incluent jamais le contexte dans lequel s'inscrit le problème. Ce contenu centre presque toujours les politiciens et organisations israéliens, ainsi que les représentants du gouvernement et de l'armée israéliens; les voix palestiniennes ne sont que rarement centrées ou représentées.

Un [éditorial](#) récent publié par Al Jazeera souligne que seulement deux publications canadiennes ont rendu compte d'un nouveau [rapport](#) d'Human Rights Watch concluant qu'Israël est coupable de crimes contre l'humanité contre les Palestiniens s'échelonnant sur plusieurs décennies: La Presse Canadienne et le Globe and Mail. Les groupes israéliens traditionnels dédiés à recenser les abus humains contre les Palestiniens tels que [B'Tselem](#) ont fait la même chose.

La Société Radio-Canada, le diffuseur public canadien, n'a offert aucune couverture du rapport de HRW. Derek Stoffel, l'éditeur de la salle de nouvelles de la CBC et ancien correspondant au Proche-Orient, a expliqué ce silence en disant que la salle de nouvelles "n'a pas de ressources de reportage à lui consacrer cette journée-là".

Nous avons tous déjà entendu cela. Mais la mort de gens innocents partout dans le monde, à plus forte raison dans une région très controversée dans laquelle beaucoup de Canadiennes sont investies, mérite une couverture en profondeur, juste et équilibrée.

Notre demande est simple: qu'à partir de maintenant, tous les standards du journalisme soient appliqués à la couverture canadienne des Territoires Palestiniens Occupés. Une couverture juste et équilibrée devrait inclure le contexte historique et social, des reporters qui connaissent cette région et, crucialement, des voix palestiniennes.
