- Shared that the Standley pool is opening as soon as possible this year, and when the City closes the pools, the district teams will be practicing at the Standley pool.
  - b. Facility rentals
- Asked if there were any issues to report, none were reported.
  - c. New Turf schools and BOE award dates
- Shared that replacing fields for some schools are on the item to go on the BOE meeting on May 10, 2022 for the Summer 2022 schedule.
- Shared that replacing fields for Scripps Ranch HS (football), Hoover HS (football), Lincoln HS (football and track & field), and Muirlands MS (baseball field) is being impacted.
- Shared that the fields at Clairemont HS (football and track & field), Patrick Henry HS (football), Canyon Hills HS (football), Pt. Loma HS (football and softball), and University City (football) are tentatively scheduled for the Summer 2023.
  - d. Sand Volleyball
- Shared that Clairemont HS, La Jolla HS, Mission Bay HS, Scripps Ranch HS and University City HS have submitted the application to CIF.
- Shared that Sand Volleyball is a club sport for San Diego Unified as it is not Board of Education approved.
- Shared Cathedral, Coronado and OLP also signed up.
