

Digital Mihi/Pepeha

Students research then create digital versions of their pepeha to share or research and collate information about their identity and culture. [Video: The Importance of Pepeha](#).

Once the pepeha is completed they could share the links to the information via a blog (eg Blogger or Seesaw public blog) or class/school website, Facebook page etc. They could also create a QR code linked to their info and share this on blogs, websites etc. Check with local iwi on correct tikanga for your area.

Google MyMaps

Add pins to a map representing significant places in their mihi/pepeha eg. maunga, awa, place of birth etc.

Google MyMaps - use class account.

Movie Creation tools:

- Camera
- iPad or phone camera
- [Green Screen by Do Ink](#) - A iPad app for green-screening. Paid app, ~\$3
- [Veescop](#) - [Greenscreen app](#) - freemium greenscreen app
- Explain Everything, Show Me or Educreations can also be used to create videos.
- [Screencastify](#) - record your screen or record yourself using your Desktop/laptop/Chromebook camera. Free Chrome browser extension, saves to Google Drive. Direct add to Youtube if required. Can trim from either end of the video. 5 minute limit in the free version. [Loom](#) is another similar tool.
- [Seesaw](#) video tool - record themselves then share on the Seesaw blog
- Puppet Pals [app - free](#) or [paid versions](#) (about \$6) can be used to create videos using puppets. The paid version allows you to add your own backgrounds and characters or you can use the ones in the app. Very easy to use.

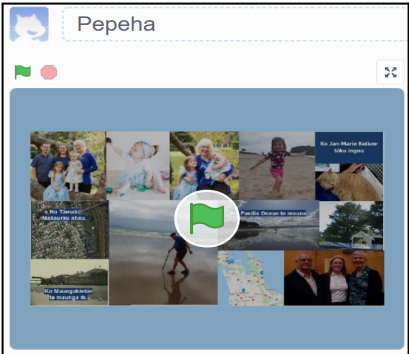

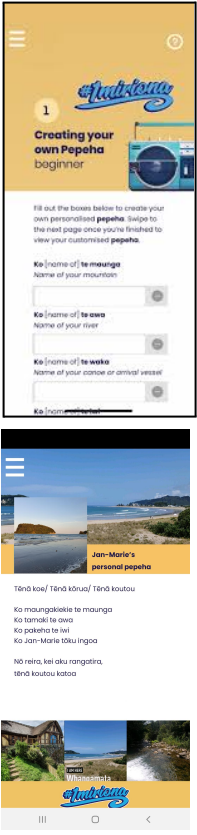
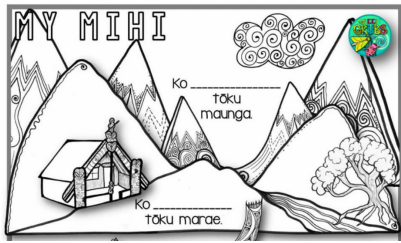

Free version is limited to 40 minutes. Some devices will allow you to use a virtual background. Movie Editing tools: imovie - ios and Mac Comprehensive video editor, The iPad version has less features than the Mac version. Both Mac and iPad versions have a green-screening facility. • Moviemaker - PC but no longer available. The Windows 10 photos app allows some editing of video • Youtube editor - Very basic editor.
