Dear Parents and Guardians:

It is with great pleasure that we announce that your child has been chosen to be a part of WEB at Monte Vista Middle school.

WEB is a program that welcomes the sixth grade class on the first day of school as well as continues to support them throughout their first year of middle school. Your child was chosen to be a WEB Leader because he or she has been identified as a person on campus who is a positive role model, responsible, possesses leadership qualities, is kind and, most importantly, has a desire to give back to her/his school community. Being a WEB Leader is an important responsibility that we hope both you and your child will take seriously.

In order to build the most effective program possible, we have a series of mandatory dates that your child must attend and arrive on time in order to be a WEB Leader.
