3	<p>How can we use student work to reflect and adjust instruction?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Using a protocol with your teacher to analyze student work• Using data to make timely adjustments to instruction based on student need
4	<p>Closing a Cycle for Impact and Meaning</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Sharing lessons learned with a wider teaching community• Identifying implications to inform future instructional planning
