Qualifications

- Knowledge of the Pennsylvania state government and political system
- Strong verbal and written communication skills
- Interest in state government, youth development, advocacy, or nonprofits
- Team and service-oriented
- Ability to work independently with minimal supervision
- Professional demeanor working with youth and adult volunteers
- Current college undergraduate (sophomore year or above preferred)
- Ability to volunteer at either Eastern Elections Convention (Saturday, November 8th) or Western Elections Convention (Saturday, November 15th)-- required. Preferred attendance at both ECs
- Capacity to work remotely for duration of internship with exception of EC (required)
- Knowledge of Youth and Government or related programs (PA Youth and Government Alumni preferred)

Essential Functions

- Administrative support
- Assistance in preparation for Youth Advocacy Academy and Advocacy Day
- Attending meetings, including any Program Committee meetings
- Supporting the PA Youth and Government program including but not limited to: curriculum development, officer support, communication with volunteers and advisors, fundraising and awareness initiatives, event preparation, branding, and leadership at Elections Conventions.

Pay and Time Commitment

This is a paid internship. You will receive a stipend of \$1,500 for your work from September to December. This will primarily be a remote position with some mandatory in-person events. Aside from mandatory volunteering at the either the Western or Eastern Elections Convention, times and schedule are flexible and will be agreed upon at the outset of the internship period. The intern should anticipate 5-8 hours per week from September to December.
