

Hello West Zone Soccer Officials:

We hope you are excited to get the 2024 Outdoor Soccer season started.

In preparation for the anticipated season start on May 1, 2024, there are a few items to draw to your attention.

Please make sure that you review and are knowledgeable with the rules for each of the age groups that you are going to referee. Keep in mind that the West Zone has some “competition rules” that are modifications to the EMSA Main rules and in some cases Alberta Soccer Association rules.

U9 Age Group- Mini-Soccer 7 V 7
