

IAU 100 KM ASIA AND OCEANIA CHAMPIONSHIPS

Only athletes and team's official entered by their National Federation can compete in the 2025 IAU 100KM Asia and Oceania Championships. Every Country can send a maximum of 9 men and 9 women who can compete in this Continental Championship. However, only 6 men and 6 women can run in the team event. The remaining athletes will participate in the individual championships only.

PRELIMINARY ENTRY FORM (PEF) AND FINAL ENTRY FORM (FEF)

DEADLINE FOR PRELIMINARY ENTRY FORM (PEF): August 1st 2025

Every country can send 9 men and 9 women athletes and can nominate one non-travelling reserve for each team in case of late withdrawal. For the teams' results, the delegations will be ranked according to the addition of the

performances of their 3 best athletes.

Maximum number of officials:

- 1-6 athletes 3 officials
- 7-12 athletes 6 officials
- 13-18 athletes 9 officials

DEADLINE FOR FINAL ENTRY FORM (FEF): October 1st 2025

With the final entry form, each Federation will send the final list with the names of their athletes, dates of birth, gender and their personal bests. Each Federation will also inform the LOC about arrival and departure times, flight numbers, train or bus times, required number of rooms and their typology and required number of nights.

COMPETITION

The START and the FINISH of the competition is in Wachirabenchatat Park (Rot Fai Park), Bangkok, Thailand.

The course is 4 km loop and it will be run 25 time. The course was officially measured and certified by World Athletics (Certificate Number: THA2023/357). The LOC will provide security at the venue for the participants and officials. Course map is provided below.

OPEN RACE

In addition to the championship race, an Open 100KM Event will be held for Men and Women.

Event Name: Ultra Park Run Open 100KM / 50KM / 24H / 12H / 6H

- Entry Fee: €80, €40, €85, €70, €40
- Registration: Registration: Managed by LOC via local platform (not IAU system)
- Participants can register online at www.ultraparkrun.com
- Accommodation: Open participants can stay at The Quarter Ladprao by UHG at the same rates as championship athletes, subject to availability.

Prizes will be awarded to the Top 3 Men and Women in the Open Event.

7. TRANSPORTATION PLAN FOR IAU CHAMPIONSHIPS

Travel to and from the airport will be arranged at no extra cost for those staying at the official accommodation for the race and the booking will be made while submitting the FEF. The transportation schedule is provided below.

- Arrival Day (21 November): Free shuttle every 2 hours from airport to official hotel
- Race Day (22 November): Shuttle from hotel to race venue departs 20:00
- Post-Race: Shuttle service from venue back to hotel after race finish
- Departure Day (24 November): Free shuttle every 2 hours to airport

8. ACCOMMODATION AND MEALS FOR IAU CHAMPIONSHIPS



9. TRAVEL GRANTS AND THE USE OF WILDCARDS

Travel Grants are provided by the International Association of Ultrarunners (IAU) to support the travel costs of participating athletes. The grants are allocated based on travel zones, which are determined by the flying time between the athlete's home country capital and the host country's capital (Bangkok, Thailand)

TEAM-Grants are paid for maximum one male and one female team, (minimum 3 runners/team). Grants are paid for maximum 3 men and 3 women/country. All these grants are cumulative.

TRAVEL GRANT WILL ONLY BE PAID BY BANK TRANSFER.

The provisional travel grant (PTG) information will be sent by email to the contact named in the PEF two weeks before the race. The provisional travel grant will need to be signed with bank details confirmed and returned to robert.boyce@iau-ultramarathon.org

At the start of the race there will be a last check of the athletes who have started. If athletes who are on the PTG information did not start the amount of TG will be changed.

Use of Wildcards

The introduction of WILDCARDS allows an athlete with 'only' a C level (or less) to be upgraded to a B-level for this MIAUC event. At each MIAUC a maximum of 2 wildcards may be used (1 man and 1 women). WILDCARDS will be automatedly added to the PTG by the IAU.

Travel Grant questions will be scheduled right before the technical meeting.

10. VISA REQUIREMENTS

All foreign visitors wishing to enter Thailand must possess a valid passport.

- Visa on Arrival: Available for selected countries. For the full list and requirements, please visit: <u>Visa on Arrival Thailand</u>
- Standard Visa: Visitors from non-exempt countries must apply at the Thai Embassy or Consulate in their country.
- Supporting Documents:
 - o Invitation letter from the LOC
 - o Hotel booking confirmation
 - o Travel itinerary

The LOC will provide necessary support for visa applications if required.

11. ACCREDITATION PROCEDURE

Accreditation badges will be prepared in advance of the event, based of the information provided by the Member Federation in the Final Entry Form (FEF).

- Pickup Location: Main registration area at Swissôtel Bangkok Ratchada
- Required Documents:
 - o Passport or National ID
 - o Confirmation of participation from the Federation

Badges must be worn at all times for access to restricted areas.

12. MEDICAL

The safety and health of all athletes and officials are a priority.

- Medical Team: A fully equipped medical team will be present at the race venue.
- First Aid Stations: Placed every 2 km along the course and at the Start/Finish area.
- Doping Control: In accordance with World Athletics and IAU Anti-Doping Policy. All podium finishers and a minimum of two random athletes will be tested.

- Therapeutic Usage Exemption (TUE): Athletes requiring TUE must provide documentation upon arrival.

13. TIMING

Timing for the event will be managed with advanced Chip Timing Technology, ensuring precise and real-time monitoring.

- Timing Provider: Ultra Park Run Timing Systems
- Timing Mats: Located at the start, finish, and every 1 km checkpoint.
- Live Tracking: Real-time tracking available online during the event.

Athletes must wear their bib and timing chip at all times during the race.
