

GAME – *Future Bets*

On a notecard, write down your name and two things you are/aren't going to do tomorrow. The teacher will collect everyone's cards. Split into two teams. Each team gets \$100 in fake money.

With the cards, the teacher will write a question on the board about what a person from the other team will do tomorrow. Work with your team to **bet** on whether your classmate is or isn't going to do the activity. If your bet is right, your team gets the money. If your bet is wrong, your team loses the money. The team with the most money at the end wins!

Example:

Is Paul (from Team B) going to work tomorrow?

Team A's bet: We bet \$20 Paul is going to work tomorrow.

Is Oscar (from Team A) going to buy coffee tomorrow?

Team B's bet: We bet \$10 Oscar is going to buy coffee tomorrow.

Notecards: I'm not going to work tomorrow. — Paul

I'm going to buy coffee tomorrow. — Oscar

Team A loses -\$20. Team B gets +\$10.
