## **Committee Position Description**

### **DIRECTOR OF REFEREEING**

<b>Appointed for a period of:</b>	2 years
<b>Reports to:</b>	Executive Director

#### **Roles and Responsibilities:**

- Attend 4 Committee Meetings per annum.
- Provide an Annual Report 30 days before the AGM and attend the AGM.
- Responsible for development of referees Australia-wide facilitating L1, L2 and L3 courses, providing Course Details to members on request.
- Works with the UHA Committee to determine allocation of Referee Funds.
- Manages the selection of and budget for providing non-playing referees at a National tournament.
- Maintains a database of current qualified referees.
- Is the responsible Tournament Director at Australian Nationals and must be in attendance. Draws up the tournament roster of Referees. Presides over Refereeing issues that arise throughout the tournament and resides on the Panel for protest / behavioural reviews along with the Games Commissioner and Convenor.
- Must attend Trans Tasman series Tournaments.
- Allocates Referees to represent Australia at Trans Tasman and CMAS sanctioned tournaments, oversees their funding decisions (in line with committee directives).
- Communicates progression of rules to States and Referees.
- Point of contact for members regarding Refereeing issues.
- Provides a 'call for nominations' to the Communications Officer when positions are being advertised.
