

# Instruction Manual: Automatic Content Asset Generator

The Asset Generator is an internal PeerSpot tool that automatically transforms user quotes, vendor information, and design templates into ready-to-use branded social cards. It eliminates manual design work, ensures consistency across assets, and allows vendors to quickly generate high-quality marketing materials directly from PeerSpot.

## Internal Set-Up

### Preparing Your PSD File (in Photoshop)

- Open the Layers panel.
- Identify decorative or placeholder elements (e.g., stars, speckles, test rectangles).
  - To remove:
    - Select the layer → press Delete, or
    - Right-click → Delete Layer.
    - Use the eye icon (👁️) to toggle visibility and confirm whether they're needed.
    - Keep only essential layers for your final design.
- Ungroup Layers
  - - Expand all folders in the Layers panel.
  - - Right-click on groups → Ungroup Layers.
  - - Verify that all elements are now top-level layers (no nesting).
- Rename layers clearly
  - - Double-click each layer's name to rename.
  - - Use descriptive names such as:
    - - Vendor Logo

- - Author Info Background
- - Author Name
- - Copyright
- - Stars
- - Avoid generic names like Layer 1 or Shape Copy.
- Converting into Artboards
  - Note, this is not always necessary, but only artboards can be exported into Abyssale
  - In the Layers panel, select the top-level group.
  - Right-click → Artboard from Group.
  - Verify artboard properties
  - Open the right-side properties panel.
  - Confirm it displays Artboard properties.
  - If the PSD contains multiple variations, ensure each has its own artboard.

## Exporting to Abyssale

- How to export via plugin
  - Open the Abyssale Photoshop plugin.
  - Select Export.
  - During export:
  - Deselect unnecessary layers (placeholders, extras).
  - Keep only design elements you want in the template.
  - After export, the template will automatically appear in your Templates Library in Abyssale.
  - No manual import is required.
- Finalizing Template in Abyssale
  - Go to the Templates Library in Abyssale.
  - Click on the asset you want to prepare for PeerSpot.

- Click Use this template.
- Rename it (based on text capacity, not vendor):
  - Small Text
  - Medium Text
  - Large Text
- Select the product destination → Basic Social Card.
- Save changes.

## Setting up Templates in Abyssale to Upload to PeerSpot

- Text elements
  - Select each text layer.
  - Enable Auto-resize text:
    - Author Name: min size ~10pt
    - Author Info: ~15pt
- Remove decorations:
  - Select the text layer.
  - In the right-hand panel, scroll to the Text section.
  - Under Text Decorations, click Clear Text Stack to remove leftover styles.
- Vendor logo elements
- Set Alignment → Center-Middle.
- Avatars (must be circles)
- To make avatars circular:
  - Select the avatar image layer.
  - Go to Mask → Add Mask in the right panel.
  - Choose Circle as the mask shape.
  - Resize and align the mask to center over the avatar image.
- Shapes & backgrounds

- Name clearly (e.g., Author Info Background, Bottom Strip).
  - Keep clean and consistent.
- Final step
  - When finished, click Save and Exit.

## Importing into PeerSpot

- Go to the Admin panel in PeerSpot.
- Click Manage Designs.
- In the top left, click Import New Template.
- Upload the template you saved from Abyssale.

### Schema Mapping

- After importing, first:
- Choose Asset Type → Social Card.
- Then map each element to schema:
  - Background → Customizable
  - Stars → Not customizable
  - Copyright → Customizable
  - Author Name → Customizable
  - Author Info → Customizable
  - Vendor Logo → Customizable
  - Author Avatar → Not customizable
  - PeerSpot Logo → Customizable
- Click Save to confirm.

## Using the Asset Generator in PeerSpot

- Go to your Vendor Dashboard.

- Open Peer Quote Assistant.
- Filter for the desired quote type.
- Select your quote.
- On the left-hand side, click Generate Asset.
- Select your custom template from the Asset Library.
  - Note: scroll down to see more asset options.
- Click Select Asset.
- Once selected, you can customize the following:
- Text (Quote, Author Name, Author Info, Copyright)
  - Select font → choose from dropdown.
  - Select font weight → 300 (Light), 400 (Regular), 600 (Semibold), 700 (Bold), etc.
  - Select color → pick from palette or enter hex code.
  - Mode (Copyright/PeerSpot logo) → toggle Light or Dark for contrast.
- Backgrounds (General, Author Info Background, Bottom Background)
  - Select background color.
  - Select secondary color (optional → creates gradient).
  - Gradient direction (left→right, top→bottom, diagonal, etc.).
  - Opacity slider (100% solid → lower % more transparent).
  - Select border color.
  - Select border width (in pixels).
- Logos
- Vendor logo:
  - Upload via image upload (PNG/JPG, transparent preferred).
  - Or provide image URL.
- PeerSpot logo:

- Toggle Light (white) or Dark (black).
  - Generate asset branding
    - Adjust fonts, colors, and backgrounds until satisfied.
    - Click the yellow Generate Asset button.
  - The system auto-fills:
    - Vendor logo
    - Author information
    - Selected quotes
  - After creation, the asset is emailed to the creator and appears in the vendor dashboard's "Asset Library".
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## Fonts (by vendor request only)

This is by vendor request only.

- Vendors must supply:
  - Format: TTF or OTF
  - Separate files for each weight (Regular, Medium, Semibold, Bold).
- Adding fonts in Abyssale
  - Go to Creative Hub → Fonts → Add Custom Font.
  - Upload font files.
  - Enter Font Family Name (must match schema name).
- Important notes
  - Each weight may require its own upload.
  - Italics not yet supported.
  - If fonts don't appear, Dev may need to clear cache.
