- Is the environmental priority considered when designing Erasmus+ projects?
- Are there monitoring or evaluation mechanisms?
- Is responsibility clearly defined at operational level?

#### **3. Strengths and Challenges**

- What are the main strengths of your institution in this area?
- What works well in practice?
- What are the main challenges or obstacles?
- Where do you see gaps between strategy and implementation?

#### **4. Recommendations**

- What could be improved in the short term (within one year)?
- What structural changes would strengthen implementation?
- How could cooperation between academic and administrative staff be improved?
- What kind of support would your institution need to better address this priority?
