- **Accountability** what will you do to hold officers accountable for their actions when they deviate from protocol? How will you increase transparency into their actions and consequences?
- **Community Engagement** how will you bridge the divide between the community and law enforcement to build the deeply needed trust in our system

I watched my neighborhood shatter to pieces last night; something must be done if we are to move forward. I lean on you—my elected representative—for support and most importantly, change.
