Other things to ask/think about:

We're looking for some help!

Communications Team Members - Someone to make fun social media posts and a newsletter assistant. This team relies heavily on Slack, so familiarity is a plus. It's important for folks on this team to be able to plan ahead and be flexible.

Fundraising Team Members - 3-4 folks as a fundraising team. Project managers for our fundraising events.

Mom's Night Out Coordinator. Someone to schedule evenings out at different venues for those who identify as moms. Ideally four evenings over the course of the school year.

Ravensbook Lead - Someone to coordinate the school-wide Ravensbook order. You don't have to create the books! Just communicate to grade level volunteers deadlines and other instructions as well as placing the order for the books with Shutterfly and distributing the books when they arrive.

Swap Lead - someone to coordinate the Fall Costume and Clothing Swap as well as the Spring Sports and Clothing Swap.

Room Parent Coordinator - This position is such an important one for school communications. The coordinator passes along relevant information throughout the year to room parents to share with families as well as leads an orientation for new room parents in the fall.
