Soloists L1, L2, L3,... L12. Share the correct pronunciation of those lycophytes and monilophytes for which you have words in your language. You will probably want to write your words on poster paper.

Botany

Groups 1-8

Teach the class the terminology in your area.

Life cycle groups 2, 4, 6, 7. Simplify a reproductive diagram and teach the class how your type of plant reproduces. What are the key distinguishing features? What do the terms listed mean?

Remember:

gametophyte = haploid = n = unpaired chromosome stage

sporophyte = diploid = $2n$ = paired chromosome stage

Does your plant produce spores? From what structures are the spores produced? What are the names of those structures?

Make a diagram but SIMPLIFY the diagram. Teach the key points.

Morphology (names of shapes and parts) groups 1, 5, and 8: teach the class the names of the parts of your plant, or in the case of group 1, your bacteria. Group 8 has the most terms to cover. Group 1 and 5 have the least terms to cover.
