#### Prep:

  - Step #3: Do Steps 1-3 (on the blue flyer) today. Before you submit your Peralta application, please let me or another adult review it.
- Pull up the <u>Google Enrollment Roster</u> on your personal laptop so you can make comments or edits to it as students complete Peralta enrollment.

#### **Fall Enrollment Script:**

"Welcome to Dual Enrollment! You are in this class because you indicated your interest in taking this Peralta

College Dual Enrollment course in our school's Course Selection process. The Peralta title of this course is:

Before we get started, please note a few things:

- Your Peralta Dual Enrollment course officially starts with the Peralta Instructor the week of August 18th.

  You are required to attend class these next two weeks because we will work on enrollment, orientation, and prepare for the college course.
- At any point, you may visit the OUSD Dual Enrollment Website and take the <u>Dual Enrollment Orientation</u>.
- We want to remind you that as an OUSD Dual Enrollment student, you are also a real Peralta College student.

#### Let's get started on enrollment.

- First off, there are some students who have taken a DE course before and therefore do <u>not</u> need to complete the Peralta enrollment steps we are doing today. Those students are [Read names that are in green in Column I and/or the names of students who have "Repeat Add" in Column G on your school's Google Enrollment Roster [12]. If I just read your name, you <u>do not</u> need to complete the Peralta app or a DE Form. You're already enrolled (or will be enrolled) in the Peralta DE course. Instead, please visit the DE website today and be sure you take the Orientation or you may work on other assignments.
- There might also be a few students here who have Peralta application issues [Read the names in red from the Peralta Google Enrollment Roster nere.] If I just read your name please come see me once I'm done reading the instructions to the whole class.
- If I did not call your name, you need to submit a <u>Peralta application</u> and <u>Dual Enrollment Form</u> today.
   The final Peralta add/drop deadline is <u>Friday</u>, <u>August 29</u>, <u>2025</u>. Please do the following today during class:

Step #1: Go to https://tinyurl.com/dualenrollmentOUSD

Step #2: Go to "For Student" Tab and click on "Apply and Enroll"

Step #3: Do Steps 1-3 today. Before you submit your Peralta application, please let me review it. Your goal today is to submit your Peralta application and DE Form. Please check in with me once you complete both steps and if you do not finish today, please complete the steps at home or you might have additional class time the next time we meet. Make sure you submit your DE Form as that is the final step for enrollment. Make sure you come to the next class so we can let you know if there were any issues with

### your Peralta-enrollment. Please check your email for any communications as well.

If you decide to drop the college course you have until August 31st to drop without it showing up on your transcript. If you wish to drop please go see your counselor or \_\_\_\_\_(insert name of best person to support students) in \_\_\_\_\_(insert location) before August 30th.

Your goal today is to submit your Peralta application and DE Form today. Please check in with me once you complete both steps and if you do not finish today, please also check in with me before you leave. Once you submit your DE Form, I will receive it in my email inbox (be sure you click our high school) and I will sign your form. Assuming there are no issues with your enrollment, you will be Peralta enrolled. There is a chance there are issues with your enrollment so please be sure to check your email because that is where we will communicate with you.

If you decide you want to drop the course you have until Jan 31st to drop without it showing up on your transcript.
