Recurring Central Command Visits

- 1. You only have power on the station that you are visiting if you are there solely for Central Command related business.
 - a. Central command must announce when they have:
 - i. Boarded the station for Official Business
 - ii. Concluded Official Business
 - iii. Unofficial Business
 - iv. Taken Emergency Control of the station (Notify Based Pugilist and/or Head/Senior Admins in the event of this announcement.)
 - b. If you are there on official business:
 - i. You will have only the necessary access to perform your duties.
 - ii. Your radio channels will also reflect this access with the exception that you will always have access to the command channel.
 - iii. You go in, perform your duty to the station, and you are gone the moment you finish your task, unless you plan to stay. In which you are no longer on official business.
 - c. If you are there on Unofficial Business:
 - i. You will have only basic assistant access.
 - ii. You are free to exercise personal authority on the station, but you will not have positional authority. Meaning the captain and the other heads will <u>Always</u> outrank you, and can even order you around.
 - iii. Your radio will only have the Centcom (:y) and Common channels
 - iv. You are free to stay on the station as long as you like, be warned, Antags may be hot on your trail.
 - v. If you have decided to stay after performing official business, report to the HoP to have your accesses revoked, and your command and department encryption key turned in.

2. Patrons are considered Interns.

- a. As an Intern your duties consist of handling the day by day operations, of which include:
 - i. Faxes
 - ii. Joining an official commander's Official business
