Evidence	/6
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In each of the following categories, you must provide strong evidence that supports your planetary choice. (2 pts per question)

1. What are the characteristics of its star? 2pts
2. What important characteristics does the planet have? 2pts
3. What is the planet's eccentricity? 2pts

Reasoning	/9
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For each piece of evidence (the three above), you must also explain what the evidence means and why it is important (3 pts per question)

Potential Issues	/2
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Identify at least 2 potential issues with your chosen planet

Neatness/Use of Class time	/5
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- Used class time well
- Presentation is neat and easy to read
- Includes use of relevant pictures or diagrams
- Works Cited included on the last slide
