ALL-EUROPE CHEERLEADING SELECTIONS

1. ALL-EUROPE CHEERLEADERS

Cheerleaders are selected for the All-Europe 1st team and for the All-Europe 2nd team (numbers TBD) based on overall skill level and team performance for the season. These individual awards go to the top cheerleaders across divisions.

Each team may submit a maximum of 5 cheerleaders. However, coaches should be discerning in making their selections and only the absolute best cheerleaders should try out. If you do not have anyone outstanding, it is perfectly acceptable to not submit any videos. The question coaches should ask themselves is: "Does the cheerleader have the skills and abilities of the top cheerleaders in Europe?"

2. VIDEO TRYOUT

A. **Submissions and Video Requirements:** Videos will be submitted online by Wednesday, January 29. The cheerleader will perform the following skills **IN ORDER** without any breaks in the video. The video should not be edited in any way.

B. Required Skills:

Running Tumbling – one tumbling pass on entrance

Standing Tumbling – one skill/series

Jumps - a toe touch, an additional single jump of choice, and a combination jump (i.e., double toe touch)

- C. **Attire:** Cheerleaders trying out for All-Europe are required to wear a plain white t-shirt and solid dark-colored shorts. The mascot, team colors, and school name will be uniform for all performances as outlined above.
- D. **Scoring:** Each cheerleader applicant will be scored by a panel of DoDEA cheer judges according to the <u>rubric</u>. Results will be sent out by the DoDEA Athletic Director at the end of the season along with the results of the other winter sports.
