P/SAT Testing Update

We successfully provided the PSAT 9, PSAT 10, and SAT to our students on April 13. There will not be a makeup exam for freshmen or sophomores that were absent on April 13. Juniors and seniors that still need to test will take the makeup SAT on Tuesday, April 26 and will be contacted with testing room locations. This SAT is a state graduation requirement that all students must have to earn a diploma from Lakes Community High School.

Students that have a College Board account will be able to log in to see their scores and can use these directions: Student Access to Scores in the College Board Reporting Portal. Juniors will be able to see their scores starting May 4th; freshmen and sophomores will start to see scores May 20. This is a rolling release meaning scores will be posted as they are processed so some will take longer to post from College Board.

Scores will be loaded into Infinite Campus under the "assessment" tab once they are received at the school level, which is typically 2 - 3 weeks later than the student release.

Sexual Assualt Presentations NEW

In compliance with Illinois Public Act 096-1524 beginning Monday, April 26 and Tuesday April 27 all seniors in physical education classes will participate in a Prevention Program presented by trained specialists from the Zacharias Sexual Abuse Center. Topics discussed in this program include dating violence, gender equality, risk reduction, self-defense, and dispelling myths about sexual assault.

The purpose of the program is to teach students to recognize and cope with potentially difficult or risky situations. Students learn strategies of assertiveness, peer support, and respect for differences. The program is presented in a single class period led by a trained presenter. A Lakes staff person will be present for each presentation.
