

Sample Classroom Entry Routine:

Guiding Questions:

Three guiding questions:

- What will the teacher be doing at every moment of the routine?
- What will the students be doing?
- What will the teacher do when a student does not respond?

Objective:

Plan and practice critical routines and procedures moment by moment:

- Explain what each routine means and what it will look like
- Write out what teacher and students will do at each step and what will happen with students who don't follow the routine

*Common Frrors to avoid:

- Teachers not having a clear vision for.
 - o Teacher actions that support effective routines
 - Desired student behaviors
- Teachers disengaged during routine

Classroom Entry: 7:30-7:42	 Stand in open doorway when the bell rings at 7:30 Angle body to see walkway and classroom Smile and greet students Monitor students in the classroom and walkway Watch for students asking permission to use the restroom/get a drink Narrate the positive Minimal redirect, when needed 	Greet teacher "Good Morning" Handshake, high five, or fist bump Voice level zero Walk to desk Take chair off desk Place backpack desk Take out materials needed for class at desk Lunch books/folders Walk to hooks Hang up backpack on hook Walk to desk and begin "Do Now" activity Read a book they unpacked or from table bin Use signals if need to use the restroom or get water and wait for teacher to approve	Standing in corner of the door (able to view walkway and classroom). Say: "Good Morning, <student name="">" Shake hands, high five, or fist bump "Good to see you this morning" Narrate the positive: "I see students hanging up their backpacks" " students are working on their "Do Now." "I hear voices on level zero." Redirect (calm, firm, neutral voice): "Hang up your backpack and walk to your seat." "All voices are on level zero." "Walk with your hands to your side." "Start on your 'Do Now' activity" "Read when you are finished"</student>
