**The second Paragraph:** introduce theories, elements and theorists, including opinions of other scholars who comment this concept or theory; intervene with research papers, and articles applying this the theory.

**The third Paragraph:** write the objectives or goals of the article, explain, either argue or support or new information/data which will be the compass to direct the applications [how? where? when?] to briefly show how to apply the theoretical concept to conduct research.

(e.g. this article presented.....the structure and content, practically, it follows the objectives or issues consistent to the article Title and the benefits for academic or social...2-3 references should be taken from the journal the author determines to be published).
