Student Trustee: Jade Shonette At our October 14 Board meeting, the Board of Trustees Adopted the Resolution No. 20.13 in Support of State Proposition 15. We also discussed the digital divide that students across California are struggling with and how our district is contributing and supporting our students. In SSPC on 10/14 we made an amendment to the bylaws in regards to the co-chairs "term in office". ## 7) Special Presentations

a) Equality and Safety of Students

BSU President Nigel Hawkins / 12 minutes

Here to touch on the Black Student Union list of demands for the future of safety and equality needed to make school a safer place for all people. These demands are because they are tired of being ignored, and today, there is still a whole wave of people dissonant to racial inequality. Education means so much to me because it is a platform to use my voice. Our list of demands start off with:

- Demand 1: the expulsion of Jordan Brandonberg and the removal of Tony Luca.
- Demand 2: Proper investigation of all reports of racism, racial discrimination, and microaggressions.
- Demand 3: Mandatory online and in-person module highlighting systemic internal and external racism each year.
- Demand 4: Equity trainings for all faculty.
- Demand 5: Development of racial discrimination registry for all employees organized by priority.
- Demand 6: Support from Classified, Academic, and Student Senates.

We need these plans to be developed and taken seriously. This is long-term and what we need to further equality and push the safety needed in our school district. We'd like to hire a black academic counselors, personal counselors, and teaching faculty. We'd like to publish an article in the Advocate regarding faculty member's behavior and emphasize equity in hiring.

President Dr. Moore shares that the investigations with Jordan Brandonberg and Tony Luca are still ongoing, and we are prohibited by law to make any actions on it specifically while the investigation is still ongoing.

Dean Hartman shares that we can't make specific comments and are in the process of adjudicating matters of this nature due to the protections we must honor. Our college and our district has made clear our commitment toward doing the hard and challenging work to becoming an anti-racist institution. Dean Hartman would be happy to meet with Nigel one-on-one to talk about these processes.

- The implementation of a Zero Tolerance Policy for racial discrimination
- District transparency on incidents of racial discrimination
- Develop a Racial Discrimination Registry for employees
- Organize by priority
- Get support from Classified, Academic and Student Senates Present to campus administration, Chancellor, and Board of Trustees with unity
- Everyone on the same page
- Decide on a consequence Idea."
