## **Alternative Education Update:**

Eight students attended the Alternative Program Summer School session, which was held May 31-June 30. Students worked on earning credits and credit recovery. Direct instruction time, online work, 1:1 work time, and hands-on experiences were provided which allowed the students a variety of different learning styles.

Ms. Higgins taught a direct instruction class on Shakespeare. The class focused on relating Shakespeare to today's society, learning the definition of the Old English words/phrases and analyzing the characters. The class ended with everyone attending Shakespeare on the Green, held on the UNO campus.

Mr. Fustos taught a direction instruction on Outdoor Living. The students learned to tie various knots, how to fish, and identify various fish and shrubs.
