SUBJECT: 21-22 CIC 48: Courses reviewed and approved by GEOC on 3/9 not requiring Senate approval

PURPOSE: Information item to the Academic Senate

ACTION REQUESTED: That the Academic Senate be informed of the summary list of courses approved by GEOC and CIC in one of three categories I. GEOC recertifications with no revisions, II. GEOC recertifications with non-actionable revisions, III. Non-actionable revisions to GEOC courses

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

On 3/21/2022, CIC approved 4 courses previously reviewed and approved by GEOC as newly certified GE, Overlay or Code courses, recertified GE, Overlay or Code courses or previously certified courses with revisions which, as specified in [19-20 CIC 123](#), require Senate approval.

In order to streamline the process, since these GEOC approvals are generally uncontroversial, CIC has changed its procedure and now refers the documents to Senate with a single master designation code (e.g. 21-22 CIC 48) in a [summary table](#), with each course listed by a subsidiary designation code (e.g. 21-22 CIC 48-1 through 21-22 CIC 48-4). This summary table is linked in this document and lists the designation code, the course number, the course title, the proposal type/description (e.g. new certification), the GE area, the Overlay/Code area, the date approved by GEOC, GEOC notes and the CIC approval date.
