<p><b>Happiness</b> Create a sketchbook page drawing that shows a pattern of design that is HAPPINESS to you.</p> <p><b>Example: The work of artist Brad Eastman makes me feel happy. I enjoy his color palette and patterns that he uses.</b></p>		
<p><i>Give Thanks. Draw a picture of something that you are thankful for.</i></p> <p><b>Steps:</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Brainstorm and create a list of things that you are grateful for. Example: sunshine, chocolate, a friend or family member.</li> <li>2. Create sketches of a few of these ideas. Discuss and show ideas to a friend or family member. Select the best idea.</li> <li>3. Select the best medium for the artwork. It should be something that you feel comfortable with and will convey your message.</li> <li>4. Make the artwork a completed, polished work of art that can be given to a friend or family member.</li> </ol>		
<p><b>Window Drawing</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Use a viewfinder to capture a composition that includes a window.</li> <li>● Create 3- 5 thumbnail sketches of the window</li> <li>● Select the best composition</li> <li>● Create a detailed pencil drawing of the window and what you see through the window. Be sure to include checklist.</li> </ul>		

<p><b>If You Were A Flower What Flower Would You Be?</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Research types of flowers.</li> <li>● Create 3-5 thumbnail sketches of flowers and compositions.</li> <li>● Select the strongest composition.</li> <li>● Create a drawing of the flower that you would be in a medium of choice.</li> </ul>
