Tanzania Mission Trip to Mdori Orphanage

19 members from Abiding Grace Lutheran Church joined Pastor Chove and George Muro (founders of Mdori Orphanage) on mission trip to Tanzania to devote time in fellowship and service at Mdori Orphanage. We worshipped with the 14 children and their caregivers, toured the orphanage buildings and their school. We celebrated the official opening of their bathroom facility, painted their buildings, purchased bedding materials (mattresses, sheets, pillows, mosquito netting) and brought games to play with the children that we left there for them to enjoy. We also enjoyed several safaris during our visit to Tanzania.

Members presented information about their trip on Sunday, August 3rd, and all loose cash offerings in August will go to Mdori Orphanage.

San Gabriel Back To School Supply Drive

During the month of July we collected various school supplies and then several of our members (Pastor Christine, Arthur, Lori, and Madison Anderson and Will Canole) delivered the supplies to San Gabriel on Sunday August 3rd and helped families choose needed supplies for the upcoming school year at their Back to School event.

AGLC Property Committee Minutes 8/4/25 Old Business: Review the Property Projects sheet and update. 2025-2026 Property budget status: The budget includes funds to pay Bowman for maintaining the Grounds. Rotation of Property Leadership: We discussed the need to rotate the Chairpersons positions. Tim S has expressed interest at the June meeting in continuing in his role as "co" or "vice" chair, which would include managing the interior features of the buildings. Craig will speak with a member who wants to serve on the committee and who may be willing to serve as Co-Chair. New Business Vendor quotes for lawn and garden maintenance. Tim moved and Alan seconded a motion to engage Bowman Landscape and Construction to maintain the grounds at AGLC. The Committee discussed and unanimously decided to engage Bowman. The Property Committee needs to work with the Dudes so that mowing does not interfere with cooking and, at the same time, weeds are kept under control: Craig noted Bowman mows during the week, not on Saturdays. What areas of the facility are currently on a signup list? Is the Property Committee meeting on the schedule? Jo includes the schedule for rooms and the Pavilion on the monthly AGLC calendar. Doors, stairs, porches, and railings require painting. A member is asking for potential Scout Eagle projects. Craig will follow up.
