First Aid Room Setup

The following items should be provided in the room:

- First aid kit appropriate for the workplace
- Hygienic hand cleanser and disposable paper towels
- Examination couch with waterproof surface and disposable sheets
- Examination lamp
- Cupboard for storage
- Container with disposable lining for soiled waste
- Container for the safe disposal of sharps
- Bowl or bucket (minimum two litres capacity)
- Electric power points
- Chair and a table or desk
- Telephone and/or emergency call system
- Names and contact details of first aiders and emergency organisations

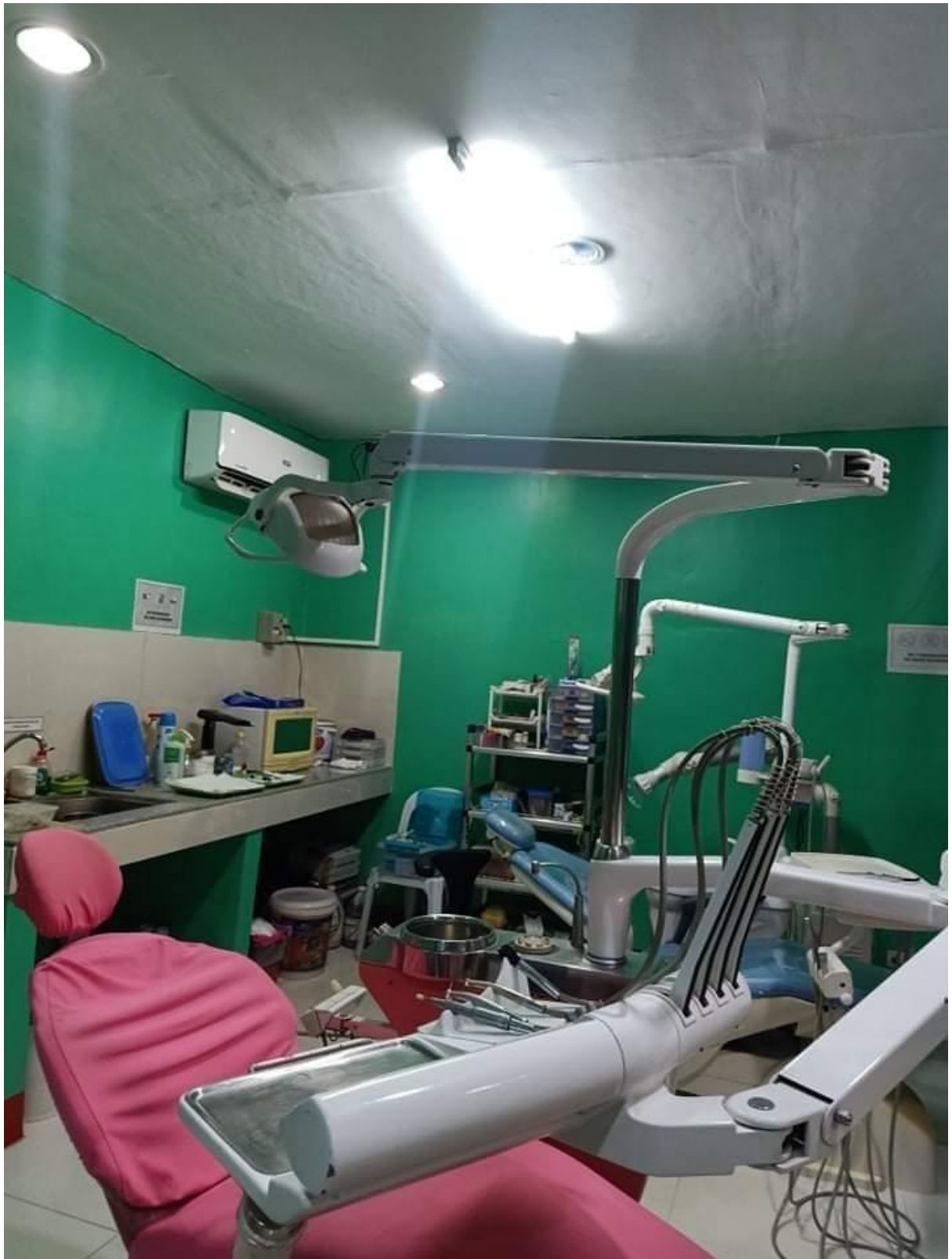
A first aid room should:

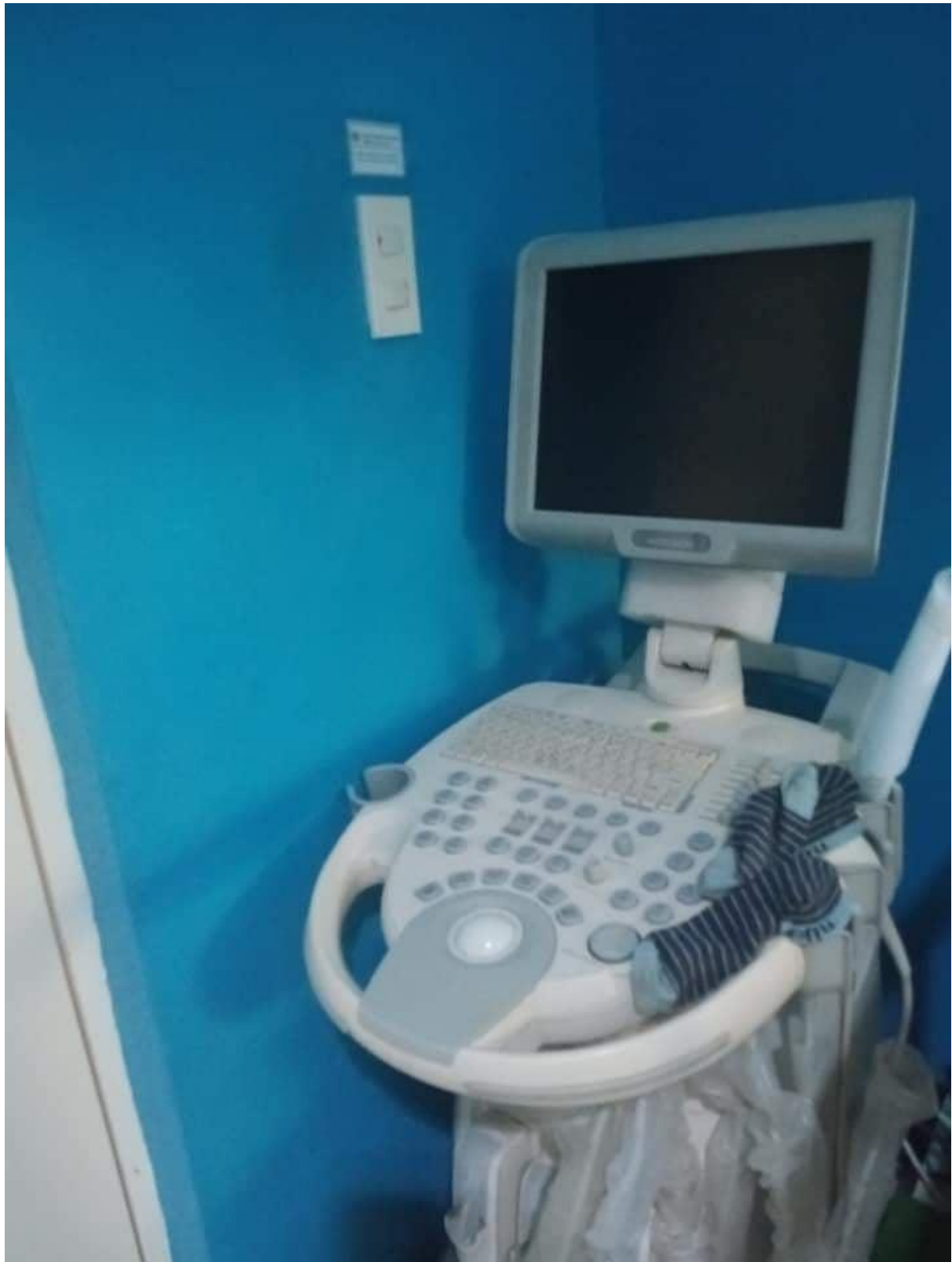
- Be located within easy access to a sink with hot and cold water (where this is not provided in the room) and toilet facilities
- Offer privacy via screening or a door
- Be easily accessible to emergency services (minimum door width of 1 metre for stretcher access)
- Be well lit and ventilated
- Have an entrance that is clearly marked with first aid signage
- Maintaining a first aid room should be allocated to a trained occupational

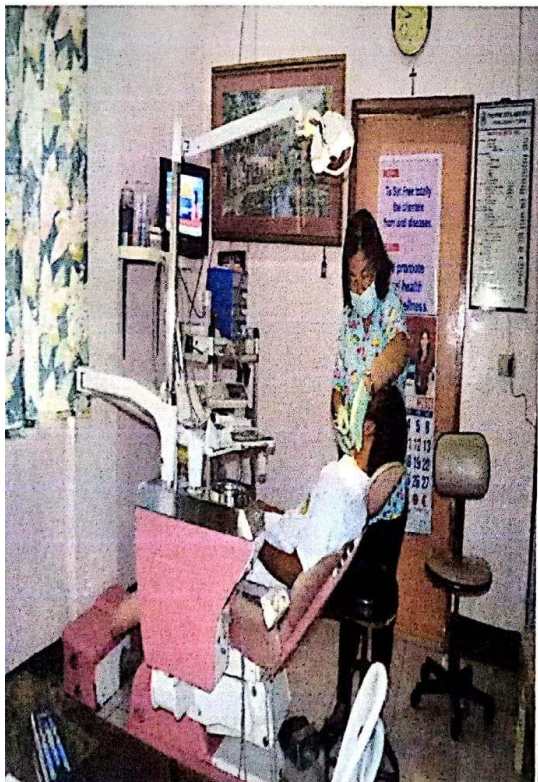
Dental Clinic
