

Who Should Sign My MOU?

Be sure to contact the appropriate people to **clarify who will review & sign your MOU before** you fill out the form.

In many cases, if an MOU is for **services in just one school** the principal may sign it. MOUs naming **more than one school** must be **signed by a central SFUSD administrator**. If you're not sure who is appropriate, email Partnerships@sfusd.edu
