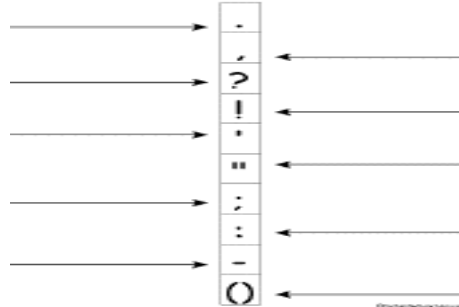
Important Words

key detail (noun): an important part of a text.



A **key detail** from the text "Dry Days in Australia" is that the country has laws about how much water people can use.

punctuation (noun): the marks, such as period, comma, and parentheses, used in writing to separate sentences and their elements and to clarify meaning.



viral (adjective): relating to or involving an image, video, piece of information, etc., that is circulated rapidly and widely from one Internet user to another.
