What is a system?

A set of objects that interact and influence each other to perform a task or function.

Systems can be living or nonliving, as small as a cell, or as large as a solar system.

Objects in a system can be almost infinite and include organisms, machines, processes, ideas, numbers, organizations, or energy.

Systems involve...interrelationships, processes, flows of energy, matter and patterns.
