Welcome to the @ab_vax Covid-19 Vaccine Booking Guide! You can book your vaccine in Alberta in the following 4 ways:

- 1. Contact a pharmacy using the Blue Cross Pharmacy List
- 2. Call 811
- 3. Find a local physicians office (instructions start at the top of page 3 of this document using <u>this link</u>)
- 4. Central booking at an AHS site or pharmacy using <u>this link</u> with instructions starting at the bottom of page 3 of this document

Booking your vaccine in Alberta has become centralized, meaning you can now book your vaccine at a pharmacy or Alberta Health vaccine clinic in one convenient location!

Current eligibility is as follows:

First and second doses available to those aged 12+. Book now.	
First Dose: those born in 2009 or before	
Second Dose: those who received their Pfizer or Moderna first dose 28 days ago or more, see details and video	
Additional Doses: all seniors living in congregate care facilities, immunocompromised and travellers to jurisdictions where AstraZeneca / Covishield or mixed doses are not recognized will be <u>eligible</u>	ł
AstraZeneca / Covishield: Bookings are only available through Health Link by calling 811	
Walk-In Clinics: No appointment COVID-19 immunization clinics	

Specific immunocompromising conditions that make an individual eligible for a third dose:

-solid organ transplant recipients - pre-transplant and post-transplant

-hematopoietic stem cell transplants recipients — pre-transplant and post-transplant while in immunosuppressed state (post-HSCT individuals are generally considered to be immunocompetent after 3 years as long as they are not on immunosuppressive drugs)

-individuals with malignant hematologic disorders and non-hematologic malignant solid tumors prior to receiving or receiving active treatment which includes chemotherapy, targeted therapies, and immunotherapy or having received previous COVID-19 vaccines



while on active treatment (does not include individuals receiving solely hormonal therapy, radiation therapy or a surgical intervention)

-individuals on anti-CD20 monoclonal antibodies (such as rituximab, ocrelizumab, and ofatumumab)

-individuals with chronic kidney disease on peritoneal dialysis or hemodialysis

Albertans living in congregate care facilities should be vaccinated with their third dose within their facility in the near future. Please check with your individual care site to verify the date of the third dose. If you would like to get vaccinated earlier, read on!

If you are fully vaccinated with AstraZeneca or a combination of AstraZeneca and an mRNA vaccine (Pfizer or Moderna), you are also eligible for additional doses of an mRNA vaccine in order to fulfill entry requirements into other countries. At this time, additional doses for upcoming travellers are being done on the honour system.

Guidance for Healthcare Pr	actitioners- boses for travel purposes
Immunization series completed	Doses that can be offered for travel purposes (Follow the recommended interval between doses)
Person has received 2 doses of the same mRNA vaccine	No additional dose can be provided
Person has received 1 or 2 doses of COVISHIELD	Give 2 doses of an mRNA vaccine at least 28 days apart
Person has received 1 or 2 doses of AstraZeneca	Give 2 doses of an mRNA vaccine at least 28 days apart
Person has received a mixed schedule of two different vaccines that are not mRNA vaccines (e.g., COVISHIELD/AstraZeneca mix)	Give 2 doses of an mRNA vaccine at least 28 days apart
Person has received a mixed schedule of two different vaccines where one dose was an mRNA vaccine (e.g., AstraZeneca/Pfizer)	Give 1 dose of the mRNA vaccine already given at least 28 days from the last COVID vaccine dose
Person has received 2 different doses of an mRNA vaccine (i.e., Pfizer and Moderna)	Give 1 dose of an mRNA vaccine already given at least 28 days from the last COVID vaccine dose.
Person has received 2 doses of a vaccine in the context of a clinical study for a vaccine not yet authorized (e.g., Medicago)	Give 2 doses of an mRNA vaccine at least 28 days from the last COVID vaccine dose.

You can also filter by clinics accepting new patients, gender of physician, language spoken by physician, after hours availability, and wheelchair accessibility. Once you find a clinic in an area that you like, you can call them to book your appointment.

First, second and additional doses for eligible Albertans		
New Government of Alberta immunization appointment booking tool, the Alberta Vaccine Booking System, gives users one point of access for all vaccination centres and pharmacies in the province.		

You have two options - Register online or Register by phone. If you choose to register online, it is best to have your Alberta Health Card ready. If you register without your AHC you will delay the confirmation receipt with the booking code, often by a few days. Many Albertans are not receiving their registration code even with AHC



inputted, so our current recommendation is to call 811 to book your appointment by phone.

Register online or by phone to be notified when you're eligible to book an appointment. After you register, you will receive a text, email or phone call when you are eligible to book a vaccine appointment.

Call Health Link at 811 if you have already registered on this booking platform and require another dose. Please do not use this system to register more than once, at this time.
